LOOKING BACK

It all started in 2007 when a few like-minded KREC Alumni got together and decided that they must support the education of the needy. Initially, these efforts were individually driven, but the idea of formalising this through NITK Sneha germinated in 2018.

Partnering with Dream School Foundation, Bengaluru, NITK Sneha started the Vidya Unnati classes for 8th, 9th and 10th grade children in 2018, mainly focused in Bengaluru. These children were selected from mainly Government schools and from LIG families. Over the last three years, Sneha and DSF have managed to bring 150 High school students under its Vidya Unnati programme.

In 2021, we expanded our program to 11th and 12th standard Science, with a tie up with UR Academy - an educational partner based in Bengaluru. UR Academy's founder Dr. G K Bhat has a successful track record of having trained hundreds of students who have qualified in IIT JEE & NEET.

Sneha has a target of doubling their student reach this year; towards this we have embarked on a massive program of expanding our educational partners, NITK Alumni volunteers and CSR partners.

We encourage the NITK Alumni and their family to join us in our effort to improve the quality of education and access to opportunities for underprivileged children. Be a part of the NITK Sneha and make a difference to the society.

COVID CHALLENGES OF 2021-22

The Covid completely derailed our efforts which primarily were classroom based. The online classes brought in a new challenge with students struggling to get internet devices to attend the virtual classes. Sneha got into action by providing immediately 100+ customized tablets for



attending the online classes. With the help of Dream School Foundation, we were able to provide access to educational lessons from industry leaders such as Byju's etc. Despite these challenges, we have increased our student enrolment rapidly to 150 students in 2021-22. With the learnings from Covid challenges, we plan to use hybrid delivery in the coming years.





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MONTHLY LECTURE SERIES

This event features a talk every month by an eminent speaker on topics of interest to our volunteers and students. We had talks by prominent personalities from the field of education and from reputed institutions such as Azim Premji University, our NITK Alumni etc. The topics are typically oriented towards challenges in teaching and emerging teaching pedagogies
